3.e. Approval of Audit Report of OSH&FWS for the year 2018-19.

Approved.

The audit report of OSH&FWS for the year 2018-19 has been prepared based on the audited figures of individual programmes being implemented by it. The report is placed before the Executive Committee for kind perusal and approval.

There were no major observations found in the report except some deficiencies with regard to internal control mechanism and processes being followed. A compliance meeting was held with officials from districts in the presence of Statutory auditor before submitting the report to GoI. Action have been taken against most of the observations and dropped by the auditor accordingly. However, Necessary instructions have already been issued to the districts to comply the rest of the observations of the auditors in action and to strictly adhere to the guidelines in the above areas in future. Further, since Ageing of Advances is one of the vital tools for early liquidation of advances, all the districts and CHSs have been instructed to ensure the same.

The major audit observations are placed at **Annexure-C**.

Annexure-C

Major Audit Observations for the year 2018-19

- Advances have been outstanding for the period of more than six months in case of civil works without proper follow-up for settlement.
- Bank Balance of Rs 481.87 Crore remained unspent as on 31.03.2019 at State, District and Block level which is 70% of the Central allocation of Rs 692 Crore after excluding IM and kind grant for the FY 2018-19.
- Instances of delay in deposit of TDS and EPF in most of the districts. Such delay attracts a levy of interest @1.5% per month for the period of delay, resulting in unnecessary loss to the organizations.
- Lack of proper tendering process for hiring of vehicles in most of the districts.
- Periodical physical verification of Fixed Assets is not done at all facilities.
- The appointment of Concurrent Auditors and submission of report by the auditors have been delayed due to late appointment of concurrent auditor.
- Payments are being made through block persons instead of directly to the party in some cases.
- Under the guidelines, vehicles hired should not be more than 2 years old. However, this is not the case in various cases.
- Current liabilities shown in the audited balance sheet as on 31.03.2019 amounting to Rs 124.53 crore needs to be settled during the current financial year.
- Ageing of advances is not followed by all districts.

The Executive Committee may kindly approve the Audit report of 2018-19 as above.

3.f. Ex-post facto approval of revision in Delegation of Financial Powers with respect to the Signatories in view of implementation of SNA.

Prior to implementation of Single Nodal Agency (SNA) strategy, the districts had separate bank accounts for each programme of NHM with the concerned Programme Officers such as DPHO, ADPHO (TB), ADPHO (FW), DMO, ADPHO (Lep) etc as one of the signatories. After implementation of SNA, there is only one zero balance virtual accounts at district level to which so many signatories can not be added due to implementation issues.

So for smooth implementation of SNA strategy, the financial powers with respect to signatories to the PPAs/cheques or signing through DSC has been revised at district level and communicated for execution as placed at **Annexure-D**, which may please be approved post-facto.

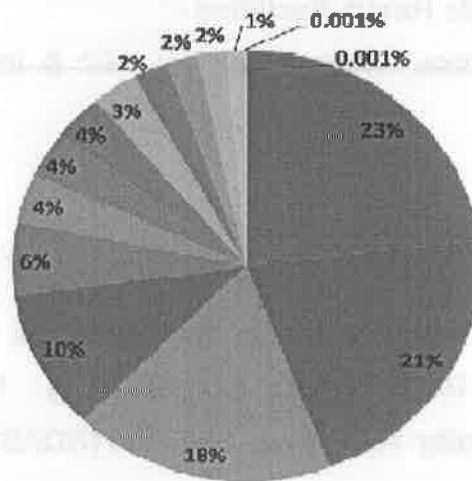
